Grant Barclay writes about the tour:

The Holy Land is steeped in history and significance. The people who live there on one hand are world leaders in different fields, but on the other hand are immersed in situations of conflict, injustice and fear. We will visit some of the key sites connected with the Hebrew people, the life and ministry of Jesus, and the early church. As we visit the places and our partner organisations across Israel and Palestine, we will spend time with the people, developing our understanding of the history and the contemporary challenges faced. In doing so, our faith will be informed and energised.

Grant Barclay, Minister at Giffnock: Orchardhill, produced the film 'Between the Lines' after spending six weeks in Israel and Palestine in 2017.

Staying 3 nights in the Scots Hotel, Tiberias, 4 nights in St Andrew's Guesthouse, Jerusalem, and 3 nights in Bethlehem, the tour will primarily be of interest to those who are returning after a long absence or who have never been. The cost will be in the region of £1,700 per person in a double room (single supplement £500) and covers flights from Edinburgh, half board accommodation, on-ground transportation, guide, entrance fees, gratuities and insurance. Places are limited; the closing date for applications is 30 April 2019.
