Property

C listed church (with B listed burial aisle) built on the site of an earlier medieval church dates back to the 18th century and is situated in the seaside town of Carnoustie. The property comprises:

Main church hall, mezzanine gallery, meeting room, crypt/vault and adjacent car park.

The sale is the footprint of the building only, together with the car park. The graveyard is owned and maintained by the Local Authority. There are rights of access over the car park in favour of the adjacent cottages.

The sellers retain the right to remove ecclesiastical fixtures and fittings, and any war memorials.

Services

The property is connected to mains supplies of water, gas and electricity. Drainage is assumed to be into a septic tank.

Planning

This C listed building could be used, without the necessity of obtaining change of use consent, as a crèche, day nursery, day centre, educational establishment, museum, art gallery or public library. It also has potential for a variety of other uses, such as a theatre, cinema or entertainment venue, retail space or community resource subject to obtaining appropriate consents. The burial aisle and "louping stone" (in the car park) are B listed.




The property contains a burial aisle and vault which were part of an earlier building and there are also likely to be buried remains under the present building. There are known to be a number of historic remains within the burial aisle and vault forming part of the property, as well as in other parts of the building, with the last known interment being in 1888.


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
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
Local Area
