

Property

Well-presented church and hall situated in the village of Friockheim in an attractive agricultural area in Angus. The property comprises:

Local Area


The popular village of Friockheim is located approximately 9 miles east of Forfar and 7 miles north west from Arbroath.

The property is just a 15-minute drive to the east coast which boasts beautiful views. The A92 is easily accessible and connects to the north and south east coast routes, ideal for commuters.








