GIFT AID IS GOOD NEWS

Gift Aid is a government scheme which allows congregations to reclaim the tax you have already paid on the money you give in your offering.

- Gift Aid is good stewardship. Giving through Gift Aid increases the value of your offering by 25% at no extra cost to you.
- Tax recovered on Gift Aid offerings increases the annual income of Church of Scotland congregations by more than £9 million.
- Increased income means congregations can do more to share the gospel and support their communities.

Who can give through Gift Aid?

Anyone who pays UK Income Tax or Capital Gains Tax. If this applies to you, please ask your Congregational Treasurer or Gift Aid Convener for a Gift Aid Declaration Form.
